## BIPA-VEHICLE SAFETY TECH

### Summary

SB2051 amends the Biometric Information Privacy Act to exempt entities using vehicle safety technology for safety purposes from its provisions.

### Business Impact

If you use vehicle safety technology in Illinois, you must ensure biometric data is not retained longer than necessary or face legal scrutiny.

### Key Provisions

- Exempts entities using vehicle safety technology for safety purposes from BIPA.
- Biometric identifiers must not be retained longer than necessary.
- Biometric identifiers cannot be used to identify individuals.

### Compliance Checklist

- Ensure biometric data is not retained longer than necessary for safety purposes. | Who: Entities using vehicle safety technology. | Penalty: Potential legal scrutiny.
