

## BIOMETRICS-PRIVATE DETECTIVES

### Summary

This bill allows licensed private detectives and security contractors to collect facial scans for law enforcement without prior notice requirements.

### Business Impact

If you operate a private security agency in Illinois, you must comply with retention guidelines for facial scans or face legal consequences.

### Key Provisions

- Allows collection of facial scans by licensed private detectives for law enforcement without prior notice.
- Entities must establish a retention schedule for biometric data.
- Data must be destroyed within 30 days unless exceptions apply.
- Entities must comply with other requirements set forth in the Biometric Information Privacy Act.
- Prohibits selling or profiting from biometric information.
- Requires protection of biometric data using industry standards.

### Compliance Checklist

- Establish a retention schedule for biometric data. | Who: Private detectives and security contractors. | Penalty: Legal consequences for non-compliance.
- Ensure destruction of biometric data within 30 days of last interaction. | Who: Private detectives and security contractors. | Penalty: Legal consequences for non-compliance.
