Condemning antisemitism in all its forms, including the proliferation and amplification of antisemitic content on artificial intelligence (AI) platforms, urging robust, transparent safeguards for AI, and recognizing stakeholders working to counter this threat.

Comprehensive

Last Action (Dec 18, 2025): Referred to the Committee on the Judiciary, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.

Summary

This bill condemns antisemitism in all forms, particularly on AI platforms, and urges robust safeguards while recognizing stakeholders countering this threat.

Business Impact

If you use AI for content moderation, you must implement safeguards against antisemitic content to avoid potential backlash.
