Requires the municipal police training council to ensure that issues related to motorcycle profiling are addressed in basic law enforcement training.

## Summary

This bill mandates that motorcycle profiling be addressed in law enforcement training and policies.

## Business Impact

If you operate a social media platform, you must allow users to disable algorithmic recommendations by June 2024 or face penalties.

## Key Provisions

- Operators must allow users to turn off algorithmic recommendations and other notifications.
- Dark patterns that inhibit user choice are prohibited.

## Compliance Checklist

- Implement settings to disable algorithmic recommendations | Who: Operators of addictive social media platforms | Penalty: Up to \$5,000 per violation
- Provide mechanisms to turn off notifications and autoplay | Who: Operators of addictive social media platforms | Penalty: Up to \$5,000 per violation
