Artificial intelligence inventory and policies.

Last Action (Jan 13, 2025): First reading: referred to Committee on Education

Summary

The bill mandates Indiana's Department of Education to create AI guidelines, inventory AI platforms, and survey educators and students on AI use.

Business Impact

If you operate a school in Indiana, you must adopt and communicate an AI policy by the start of the next school year or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Establishes guidelines and a model policy for AI in schools.
- Creates an inventory of AI platforms used in education.
- Mandates surveys of teachers and students on AI platforms.
- Requires schools to adopt and communicate AI policies.
- Prohibits penalizing students based solely on AI detector evidence.

- Adopt and communicate an AI policy | Who: School corporations and charter schools | Penalty: Unspecified penalties for non-compliance
- Submit AI platforms for inventory inclusion | Who: Teachers and school administrators | Penalty: Unspecified penalties for non-compliance
