Summary

This bill mandates that automated tractor-trailers in Indiana must have a qualified human operator present during operation on highways for transporting passengers and goods.

Business Impact

If you operate automated tractor-trailers in Indiana, you must ensure a qualified human operator is present during transport or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Automated tractor-trailers must have a qualified human operator present during operation.
- The operator must meet all state and federal qualifications.
- Automated vehicles must comply with federal motor vehicle standards.

Compliance Checklist

- Ensure a qualified human operator is present in automated tractor-trailers during operation. | Who: Businesses operating automated tractor-trailers. | Penalty: Potential fines or operational restrictions.
