Summary

The bill mandates health care providers and insurers in Indiana to disclose their use of AI technology in health care decisions and communications with patients.

Business Impact

If you provide health care or insurance in Indiana, you must disclose your use of AI in decision-making to patients by the time of service or face potential penalties.

Key Provisions

- Health care providers must disclose AI use in health care decisions.
- Insurers must disclose AI use in coverage decisions.
- Disclosures must be made to patients and insured individuals.
