Summary

SB1967 requires utilization review organizations using AI to adhere to specific requirements and prohibits AI from making clinical determinations.

Business Impact

If you operate a utilization review organization using AI, you must comply with new requirements by the effective date or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Utilization review organizations using AI must adhere to specific requirements.
- AI is prohibited from making clinical determinations.
