Summary

This bill establishes definitions and limitations on deep fakes, sets a statute of limitations for unlawful dissemination, and imposes criminal penalties for violations.

Business Impact

If you create or distribute digital content in Kentucky, you must ensure compliance with deep fake regulations or face criminal penalties.

Key Provisions

- Defines terms related to deep fakes.
- Establishes limitations on the dissemination of deep fakes.
- Sets a statute of limitations for legal actions regarding deep fakes.
- Imposes criminal penalties for illegal dissemination of deep fakes.

Compliance Checklist

- Ensure all digital content complies with deep fake regulations. | Who: Content creators and distributors. | Penalty: Criminal penalties for non-compliance.
