AN ACT relating to protection of information and declaring an emergency.

Last Action (Feb 26, 2025): to State Government (H)

## Summary

This bill establishes standards for AI use in Kentucky, creating a governance committee and requiring public disclosure of AI usage by state entities.

## Business Impact

If you operate any department using AI in Kentucky, you must comply with new policy standards and disclose AI usage or face penalties.

## Key Provisions

- Defines terms related to artificial intelligence.
- Establishes the Artificial Intelligence Governance Committee.
- Requires public disclosure of AI usage.
- Mandates employee education and training on AI.
- Prioritizes personal privacy and data protection.
- Requires the Commonwealth Office of Technology to promulgate regulations.
- Creates a cause of action for the use of synthetic media in electioneering communication.
