## Task Force on Proactive Review of Audio and Video Recordings on Special Education Buses

### Summary

The bill creates a task force to study AI's role in reviewing recordings from special education buses for student safety, reporting by December 2026.

### Business Impact

If you operate special education transportation services in Maryland, you must prepare for potential AI implementation by December 2026 or face scrutiny.

### Key Provisions

- Establishes a task force to study AI use in reviewing recordings from special education buses.
- Task force to ensure safety and security of student passengers.
- Requires a report of findings and recommendations by December 1, 2026.
