Physical education, high school; JROTC participation fulfills requirement.

Summary

This bill mandates that local school boards accept JROTC participation as fulfilling high school physical education requirements.

Business Impact

If you operate as a mental health service provider, you must ensure compliance with AI regulations by July 1, 2024, or face civil penalties.

Key Provisions

- Mental health providers must maintain full responsibility for AI interactions and outputs.
- AI cannot be used to provide therapy without a licensed provider present.
- Confidentiality of patient records must comply with existing health privacy laws.
- Civil penalties for violations can reach up to \$10,000.
- Exemptions exist for religious counseling, peer support services, self-help materials, and educational resources.
