Summary

Developers of generative AI must publish training data documentation on their website by January 1, 2026, before releasing or modifying their systems.

Business Impact

If you develop generative AI systems in Maryland, you must publish training data documentation by January 1, 2026, or face potential regulatory consequences.

Key Provisions

- Developers must publish training data documentation on their website.
- Documentation must be available before releasing or modifying the AI system.
- Deadline for compliance is January 1, 2026.

Compliance Checklist

- Publish training data documentation on your website | Who: Developers of generative AI systems | Penalty: Potential regulatory consequences for non-compliance
