## Consumer Protection - Workgroup on Artificial Intelligence Implementation

### Summary

The bill creates a Workgroup on Artificial Intelligence Implementation to monitor AI regulation, consumer protection, and government benefits, reporting by July 1, 2026.

### Business Impact

If you use AI in your business operations in Maryland, you must stay informed about regulatory recommendations by July 1, 2026, or risk non-compliance.

### Key Provisions

- Establishes a Workgroup on Artificial Intelligence Implementation.
- Workgroup to monitor AI regulation, consumer protection, and government benefits.
- Recommendations due to General Assembly committees by July 1, 2026.
