State Department of Education and Department of Information Technology - Evaluation on Artificial Intelligence in Public Schools

Summary

This bill mandates an evaluation of artificial intelligence use in Maryland public schools, including surveys and system reviews, with a report due by December 15, 2026.

Business Impact

If you operate a public school in Maryland, you must participate in an AI evaluation survey by December 15, 2026, or risk non-compliance with state mandates.

Key Provisions

- Requires the State Department of Education to evaluate AI use in public schools.
- Mandates a survey of local school systems regarding AI applications.
- Involves the Department of Information Technology in the evaluation process.
- Final report on evaluation results due by December 15, 2026.
