## Education - Artificial Intelligence - Guidelines, Professional Development, and Task Force

### Summary

The bill mandates the Maryland State Department of Education to create guidelines for AI in education and maintain an approved tools list.

### Business Impact

If you operate a K-12 educational institution in Maryland, you must inventory AI systems annually or face potential compliance issues.

### Key Provisions

- State Department of Education to develop/update AI guidelines for education.
- Annual list of approved AI tools to be maintained.
- County boards must conduct annual inventories of AI systems.

- Conduct annual inventory of AI systems | Who: County boards of education
