Task Force to Study Law Enforcement Surveillance Technologies

Summary

This bill creates a task force to review law enforcement's use of surveillance technologies and report findings by December 5, 2018.

Business Impact

If you operate a law enforcement agency in Maryland, you must prepare for potential changes in surveillance technology use by December 5, 2018.

Key Provisions

- Establishes a task force to study law enforcement surveillance technologies.
- Requires state agencies to staff the task force.
- Mandates submission of findings and recommendations by December 5, 2018.

Compliance Checklist

- Participate in the task force discussions and provide input on surveillance technologies. | Who: State agencies involved in law enforcement. | Penalty: No specified penalties for non-compliance.
