SF1242 modifies concurrent enrollment provisions in public postsecondary education and requires MnSCU to establish a supplemental instruction program.

If you operate a public postsecondary institution, you must prepare for changes in concurrent enrollment and a new supplemental instruction program.

- Modifies concurrent enrollment provisions in public postsecondary education
- Requires MnSCU board of trustees to establish a supplemental instruction program
