Summary

HB756 authorizes Maryland law enforcement to use facial recognition technology with images captured inside a dwelling, under specified conditions, without listing specific crimes.

Business Impact

If you use facial recognition tech in Maryland, ensure compliance with HB756 for images captured inside dwellings.

Key Provisions

- Authorizes use of facial recognition technology if images are captured inside a dwelling under specified conditions, without listing specific crimes or confirming a warrant requirement.
