Summary

The HERMAN Act aims to enhance the enrollment process for retiring individuals into the Medicare program.

Business Impact

If you operate airports or related services, you must limit facial recognition technology use or face potential legal consequences.

Key Provisions

- Limits the use of facial recognition technology in airports, with exceptions for national security and law enforcement.
- Requires explicit traveler consent for technology use.
- Outlines penalties for non-compliance, including fines and suspension.
- Specifies enforcement mechanisms to ensure compliance.
