This bill prohibits biometric identifying technology in schools, allowing fingerprint identification for secure digital logins and other specified purposes.

Business Impact

If you operate schools in New York, you must ensure compliance with biometric technology regulations or face potential penalties.

Key Provisions

- Prohibits biometric identifying technology in schools except for specified purposes.
- Allows fingerprint identification for secure digital logins.
- Applies to teachers, administrators, and students.
