## Summary

HB5044 prohibits Michigan public schools from collecting or using biometric data by adding Section 1136 to the Revised School Code.

## Business Impact

If you operate a public school in Michigan, you must cease collecting biometric data immediately to comply with HB5044.

## Key Provisions

- Prohibits collection or use of biometric data by public schools (Section 1136)

## Compliance Checklist

- Ensure no biometric data is collected from students during assessments. | Who: School districts and public school academies | Penalty: Potential reputational and operational risks.
- Review and update privacy policies to comply with the new regulations. | Who: School administrators | Penalty: Potential reputational and operational risks.
