Summary

This bill creates a centers of creative artificial intelligence excellence program in Michigan, providing funding to promote AI sector development for for-profit companies.

Business Impact

If you operate a business in the creative AI sector in Michigan, you must apply for funding opportunities to support your projects or risk losing potential financial support.

Key Provisions

- Establishes a centers of creative artificial intelligence excellence program.
- Allocates up to \$18 million from the 21st century jobs trust fund for the program.
- Grants are available only to for-profit companies for specific purposes related to AI.
- Mandates a standard process for evaluating applications and agreements.

Compliance Checklist

- Apply for funding under the centers of creative artificial intelligence excellence program | Who: For-profit companies and institutions of higher education | Penalty: Potential loss of funding opportunities
- Collaborate with qualified entities as specified in the agreement | Who: Entities receiving grants | Penalty: Revocation of grants for non-compliance
