Summary

This bill requires the use of facial recognition technology for driver's license and Minnesota ID applications without detailing penalties or operational standards.

Business Impact

If you process driver's license applications in Minnesota, you must implement facial recognition technology or face compliance issues.

Key Provisions

- Facial recognition technology must be used in the application process for driver's licenses.
- The requirement applies to Minnesota identification card applications as well.
- State agencies are responsible for implementing the technology.
