Relating To Artificial Intelligence.

Last Action (May 08, 2026): Enrolled to Governor.

Summary

SB3001 mandates disclosures, safety protocols, and protections for AI users, including minors, in Hawaii. Annual reporting starts January 1, 2028, with specific information required.

Business Impact

If you use AI in Hawaii, you must comply with disclosure and safety protocols by July 1, 3000, or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Operators must issue disclosures to account holders and users of AI companions.
- Operators are required to develop protocols to respond to user prompts regarding suicidal ideation or self-harm.
- Establishes protections specifically for account holders and users, including minors.
- Annual reporting to the Behavioral Health Administration of the Department of Health begins on 1/1/2028, with specific information required.
- Violations are considered unfair or deceptive acts or practices.
