Realigning Mobile Phone Biometrics for American Privacy Protection Act

Introduced

Risk: Medium

Narrow/Targeted

Last Action (Jan 16, 2026): Referred to the Subcommittee on Border Security and Enforcement.

Summary

The bill restricts facial recognition in certain mobile apps outside ports of entry; exceptions and enforcement mechanisms may exist but are not covered here.

Business Impact

If you use facial recognition mobile apps outside ports of entry, you must cease use by the bill's enactment date or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Restricts facial recognition in certain mobile applications outside ports of entry; exceptions, enforcement mechanisms, and penalties for non-compliance are not covered without complete text.
