Prohibits use of biometric surveillance system by business entity under certain circumstances.

Last Action (Jan 13, 2026): Introduced in the Senate, Referred to Senate Law and Public Safety Committee

## Summary

Bill S1464 prohibits business entities in New Jersey from using biometric surveillance systems. Exceptions and definitions are not confirmed without the bill text.

## Business Impact

If you use biometric surveillance, you must review compliance requirements once detailed.

## Key Provisions

- Prohibits use of biometric surveillance systems by business entities. Exceptions and definitions need confirmation from the bill text.
