Prohibits collection of biometric identifier information by public or private entity under certain circumstances.

Summary

Bill S1463 prohibits the collection of biometric identifier information by public or private entities. Specific exceptions, penalties, and consent processes require verification.

Business Impact

If you collect biometric data in NJ, you must review Bill S1463 for compliance or face potential legal challenges.

Key Provisions

- Prohibits collection of biometric identifier information by public entities, with specific exceptions to be verified.
- Prohibits collection of biometric identifier information by private entities, with specific exceptions to be verified.
- Defines 'biometric identifier information' as data from biological characteristics, pending confirmation.
- Specific penalties and consent processes to be verified with the bill's text.

Compliance Checklist

- Cease collection of biometric identifier information under prohibited circumstances. | Who: All public and private entities collecting biometric data. | Penalty: Potential legal challenges.
