Relating To Artificial Intelligence Literacy Education.

Comprehensive

Last Action (Feb 03, 2026): The committee(s) on EDN recommend(s) that the measure be deferred.

Summary

HB1887 mandates AI literacy education as a graduation requirement for high school students in Hawaii, starting in the 2027-2028 school year.

Business Impact

If you operate a school in Hawaii, you must implement AI literacy education by the 2027-2028 school year or face potential penalties.

Key Provisions

- Requires the Department of Education to develop AI literacy curricula for grades 11 and 12.
- Establishes an Advisory Council for Artificial Intelligence Education.
- Creates a three-year Artificial Intelligence Education Grant Pilot Program within the Department of Education.
- Sets a condition for graduation based on AI literacy.
- Mandates reporting to the Legislature on the implementation of the curricula.
- Appropriates funds for the development and implementation of the curricula.
