Revises provisions relating to health insurance. (BDR 57-238)

Summary

This bill revises health insurance provisions, focusing on prior authorization and the use of AI by insurers, including reporting and penalties for violations.

Business Impact

If you are a health insurer using AI for prior authorization, you must comply with new reporting requirements or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Imposes requirements for prior authorization processes.
- Prescribes standards for the use of artificial intelligence by health insurers.
- Mandates the compilation and publication of reports on prior authorization.
- Establishes investigation and adjudication procedures for violations.
- Outlines civil and administrative penalties for non-compliance.
