Makes various changes relating to health. (BDR 34-674)

## Summary

This bill prohibits certain uses of AI in public schools and mental health care, requires the Department of Education to develop related policies, and restricts unqualified individuals from representing themselves as mental health providers.

## Business Impact

If you operate in public education or provide mental health services in Nevada, you must comply with new AI regulations or face civil penalties.

## Key Provisions

- Prohibits certain uses of AI in public schools.
- Requires the Department of Education to develop AI usage policies.
- Imposes restrictions on AI marketing and programming.
- Prohibits unqualified individuals from representing themselves as mental health care providers.
- Restricts AI use by mental health care providers.
- Establishes civil penalties for non-compliance.
