Revises provisions relating to education. (BDR 34-525)

Last Action (Apr 12, 2025): (Pursuant to Joint Standing Rule No. 14.3.1, no further action allowed.)

Summary

This bill revises education provisions, mandates a dashboard for attendance tracking, establishes a committee on AI use in education, and revises report transmittal by the Commission on School Funding.

Business Impact

If you operate an educational institution in Nevada, you must engage with the new AI committee by the effective date or risk non-compliance.

Key Provisions

- Establishes a dashboard for tracking daily pupil attendance data.
- Requires the appointment of a task force to develop a rubric for comparing pupil metrics.
- Creates a committee on the use of artificial intelligence in education.
- Revises the timeline for reports submitted by the State Board of Education.
- Revises provisions governing the transmittal of certain reports by the Commission on School Funding.
- Changes terms for certain appointed members of the State Board.

Compliance Checklist

- Engage with the AI committee to discuss implications and strategies for AI use in education. | Who: Educational institutions and the Department of Education. | Penalty: Non-compliance may lead to oversight issues.
