This bill updates and recodifies municipal enforcement procedures for building and fire codes in New Hampshire, introducing specific amendments to enhance compliance.

Business Impact

If you collect biometric data in New Hampshire, you must stop by January 1, 2012, or face civil penalties for violations.

Key Provisions

- Introduces specific amendments to municipal enforcement procedures for building codes.
- Includes new provisions for fire safety enforcement.
- Aims to enhance compliance with safety standards.

Compliance Checklist

- Cease collection of biometric data for identification purposes | Who: State agencies and private entities | Penalty: Civil action for damages or injunction
- Destroy biometric data upon employee termination | Who: Employers collecting biometric data | Penalty: Civil action for damages or injunction
