Requires boards of education and boards of trustees to adopt policy on use of surveillance systems with artificial intelligence capabilities.

Summary

This bill requires educational boards in New Jersey to adopt policies for using AI-enabled surveillance systems, ensuring compliance with P.L.2017, c.119 and access provisions.

Business Impact

If you operate a school in New Jersey using AI surveillance, you must adopt a policy and inform parents by the start of the next school year.

Key Provisions

- Boards must adopt a policy for AI surveillance systems.
- Policy must detail the type of data collected and its intended use.
- Boards must inform parents and guardians of the policy.
- Signage must be posted indicating AI surveillance use.
- Policy must comply with state and federal privacy laws, including P.L.2017, c.119.
- Policy must include access provisions in compliance with the Uniform State Memorandum of Agreement Between Education and Law Enforcement Officials.
