Establishes Artificial Intelligence Grant Program in Office of Secretary of Higher Education.

Summary

The bill establishes an Artificial Intelligence Grant Program to fund nonprofit education and training in AI, taking effect immediately.

Business Impact

If you operate a nonprofit providing AI education, you must apply for grants to receive funding by the next fiscal year or miss out on financial support.

Key Provisions

- Establishes the Artificial Intelligence Grant Program in the Office of the Secretary of Higher Education.
- Nonprofits must apply to participate and demonstrate comprehensive AI education programs.
- Grants awarded will not exceed \$25,000 annually to four selected nonprofits.
- Recipients must report on the use and impact of grant funds.
- Establishes the Artificial Intelligence Education Fund for grant distribution.
- Annual appropriations will be made to the fund as necessary.
- The bill takes effect immediately.

Compliance Checklist

- Submit an application to participate in the grant program | Who: Nonprofit entities providing AI education | Penalty: Ineligibility for grant funding
- Submit a report on the use and impact of grant funds | Who: Grant recipients | Penalty: Potential disqualification from future funding
