Directs professional and occupational boards to promulgate rules for licensee use of generative artificial intelligence.

## Summary

This bill directs professional boards in New Jersey to create rules for licensee use of generative artificial intelligence, with a model policy adopted within six months.

## Business Impact

If you operate a regulated profession in New Jersey and use generative AI, you must comply with new rules within six months or face penalties.

## Key Provisions

- Director must adopt a model policy for generative AI use within six months.
- Professional boards must promulgate rules based on the model policy within nine months or until their next meeting.
- Rules will initially be effective for a period not to exceed one year before needing re-adoption.
