Requires boards of education to adopt policy on use of surveillance systems with artificial intelligence capabilities.

Summary

This bill mandates education boards to adopt policies for using AI-enabled surveillance systems in schools.

Business Impact

If you operate a school in New Jersey using AI surveillance, you must adopt a policy and inform parents by the start of the next school year.

Key Provisions

- Boards must adopt a policy for AI-enabled surveillance systems.
- Policy must detail the surveillance system, data collected, and usage plans.
- Boards must comply with state and federal laws on student records.
- Signage must be posted indicating AI surveillance use.
- Policy must be distributed to parents and guardians.
