Requires Commissioner of Labor and Workforce Development to conduct study and issue report on impact of artificial intelligence on economic growth.

Last Action (Mar 11, 2019): Reported out of Assembly Committee, 2nd Reading

Summary

This bill requires a study on the impact of AI on economic growth and labor markets, with a report due within one year, submitted to key legislative committees.

Business Impact

If you employ highly-skilled professionals in New Jersey, you must prepare for potential changes in the labor market due to AI by the report's release.

Key Provisions

- Commissioner of Labor and Workforce Development to conduct a study on AI's economic impact in consultation with the New Jersey Commission on Science, Innovation and Technology.
- Report to include predictions on AI's effect on the labor market for highly-skilled professionals and be submitted to key legislative committees.
- Study to be completed within one year of the bill's effective date.
