Summary

The bill mandates the Attorney General to arrange independent testing of the accuracy of facial recognition systems within 60 days.

Business Impact

If you use facial recognition technology in New Jersey, you must undergo independent testing for accuracy by the Attorney General within 60 days of the bill's effective date.

Key Provisions

- Attorney General must arrange independent testing of facial recognition systems within 60 days.
- Testing to assess accuracy variations based on demographic factors.
- Results to be reported to the Legislature within 30 days after testing completion.
