Relating To Artificial Intelligence.

Introduced

Last Action (Feb 10, 2025): Passed Second Reading as amended in HD 1 and referred to the committee(s) on FIN with none voting aye with reservations; Representative(s) Pierick voting no (1) and Representative(s) Belatti, Cochran, Kila, Ward excused (4).

Summary

Establishes the Hawaii Artificial Intelligence Advisory Council to recommend an action plan and report to the Governor and Legislature. Effective July 1, 3000, repealed December 31, 2027.

Business Impact

If you operate a business impacted by AI in Hawaii, you must comply with new guidelines set by the advisory council by 2027 or risk regulatory scrutiny.

Key Provisions

- Establishes the Hawaii Artificial Intelligence Advisory Council.
- Requires the council to develop an action plan and submit reports to the Governor and Legislature.
- Appropriates funds for the council's operations and positions.
- Mandates cooperation from state departments and agencies.
- Includes provisions for hiring consultants to assist the council.
- Sets deadlines for interim and final reports on AI impacts and recommendations.
- Effective July 1, 3000, and repealed December 31, 2027.
- Specifies the composition of the advisory council, including state officials and appointed members.
