## Summary

Establishes a task force to evaluate the impact of facial recognition systems on civil rights and liberties of vulnerable communities, with members serving without compensation.

## Business Impact

If you use facial recognition technology in New Jersey, you must comply with the task force's findings or face potential scrutiny.

## Key Provisions

- Creation of a task force to evaluate facial recognition systems' impact on civil rights.
- Task force consists of 17 members, including representatives from vulnerable communities.
- Members serve without compensation but may be reimbursed for necessary travel expenses.
- Report of findings to be submitted within 12 months of the initial meeting, after which the task force will expire.
