AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 10; Title 24 and Title 38, relative to historical location data.

Summary

The PEEPS Act aims to amend Tennessee law regarding historical location data. Specific amendments will be detailed once the full bill text is available.

Business Impact

If you operate in Tennessee and use AI to process historical location data, you must ensure compliance with the PEEPS Act by July 1, 2024, or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Specific amendments to Titles 10, 24, and 38 will be updated once the full text is available.

Compliance Checklist

- Obtain a warrant before accessing historical location data. | Who: Law enforcement agencies | Penalty: Disciplinary actions against non-compliant officers
- Implement data retention policies as outlined in the bill. | Who: Law enforcement agencies | Penalty: Potential fines or sanctions
