This bill requires school districts to provide AI instruction and mandates the Secretary of Higher Education to develop AI model curricula.

- School districts must provide instruction on artificial intelligence.
- The Secretary of Higher Education will develop model AI curricula.
- The bill introduces AI education into the school system.
