## Summary

This bill authorizes a study on the designation of roads for future autonomous vehicle testing at the University at Buffalo and in Amherst.

## Business Impact

If you operate autonomous vehicles in New York, you must comply with new testing regulations after the study is completed or face penalties.

## Key Provisions

- Authorizes a study on the designation of roads for future autonomous vehicle testing.
- Identifies three specific testing zones in Amherst.
- Prohibits testing during the study period.
- Requires a review of local law enforcement's ability to supervise testing.
- Mandates a report to the governor and legislature within six months.
- Includes considerations for the installation of necessary technology for future testing.
