The 'Save our Jobs Act of 2019' creates a commission to study the impact of autonomous tractor trailers on truck drivers and diesel mechanics.

Business Impact

If you employ truck drivers or diesel mechanics, monitor commission findings by Feb 15, 2020, for potential workforce impacts.

Key Provisions

- §2.1 Establishment of a commission to examine the impact of autonomous tractor trailers.
- §2.2 Commission to consist of fifteen members appointed by state leaders.
- §2.3 Reports due by February 15, 2020, detailing economic impacts and recommendations.
- §2.3b Recommendations to include job training, financial resources, and health insurance options for affected workers.
- §2.3c Commission to be dissolved after submitting its report.
