

# HB3693 • United States (Federal)

To prohibit the Federal Government from establishing or maintaining a database that contains data collected through, or facilitates, the biometric identity verification of a citizen of the United States, and for other purposes.

## Summary

This bill prohibits the Federal Government from creating or maintaining a biometric identity verification database for U.S. citizens.

## Business Impact

If you operate biometric verification systems, you must ensure compliance with this prohibition to avoid federal penalties.

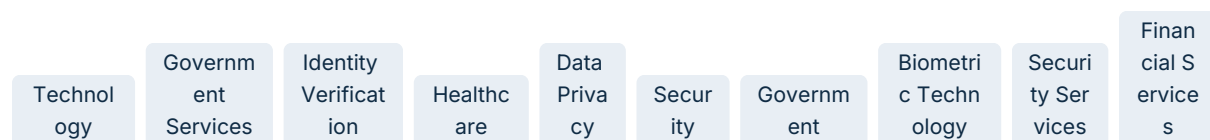
## Key Provisions

## Compliance Checklist

- Cease any plans to establish a biometric identity verification database. | Who: Federal agencies and contractors. | Penalty: Potential federal penalties for non-compliance.
