Creates a temporary state commission to study and investigate how to regulate artificial intelligence; and repeals such commission one year after this act takes effect.

Summary

This bill creates a temporary commission to study and investigate the regulation of artificial intelligence in New York.

Business Impact

If you operate in AI technology in New York, you must stay informed about potential regulatory changes by the commission's report due in 180 days.

Key Provisions

- Establishes a temporary commission to study AI regulation.
- Commission to consist of eleven members appointed by state officials.
- Final report due 180 days after the act's effective date.
- Commission members receive no compensation but can claim expenses.
- Commission may conduct hearings and gather written testimony.
- Commission to be repealed one year after the act takes effect.
