Summary

This bill mandates the New York Department of Transportation to collect data from third-party verification services for expedited security screening at public-use airports and defines terms related to the process.

Business Impact

If you operate third-party identification verification services for airlines, you must submit data to the New York Department of Transportation quarterly or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Requires the Department of Transportation to submit quarterly data reports to the governor, the temporary president of the senate, and the speaker of the assembly.
- Defines key terms related to identity verification for expedited security screening at public-use airports.

Compliance Checklist

- Submit quarterly data on passenger usage and security breaches | Who: Third-party identification verification services | Penalty: Not specified in the bill
- Provide information on the number of functioning kiosks | Who: Third-party identification verification services | Penalty: Not specified in the bill
