An act to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to a driver safety course; to amend the state finance law, in relation to a driver safety course fund; and to repeal certain provisions of such laws relating thereto

Summary

This bill establishes an internet-based driver safety course using biometric technology and creates a fund for transportation safety initiatives.

Business Impact

If you provide online driver safety courses in New York, you must implement biometric identity verification by September 1, 2009, or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Establishes an internet-based driver safety course.
- Requires biometric technology for identity verification.
- Imposes a fee of up to \$100 for course enrollment.
- Mandates annual review and update of course content.
- Creates a Driver Safety Course Fund for revenue allocation.
- Allows contracting with a software solution and network infrastructure provider.

- Develop and update course content annually | Who: Commissioner of Motor Vehicles
