Summary

Alyssa's Law establishes a pilot grant program for schools to purchase panic alert systems or AI firearm detection software.

Business Impact

If you operate a public or charter school in Ohio, you must consider applying for grants to enhance safety systems by the pilot program's launch or risk missing funding opportunities.

Key Provisions

- Establishes a pilot grant program for schools.
- Allows purchase of panic alert systems.
- Permits contracting for AI firearm detection software.
- Targets public and chartered nonpublic schools.
- Includes an appropriation for funding.
- Focuses on enhancing school safety measures.
